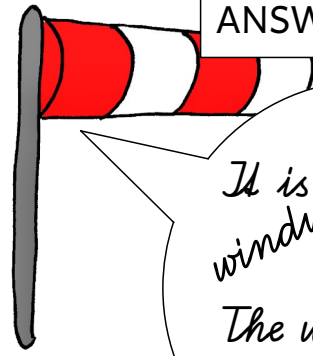
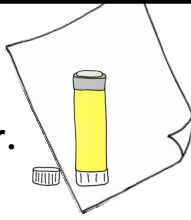


Do you remember the whole story?
