Assignments

1. Outline what the shopping experience for African Americans was like before and after the introduction of the Sears catalog. (Material 1)
2. Analyze how the effects of mail order catalogs are depicted in the article (Material 1) and in the cartoon (Material 2). Focus on use of language and visual elements.

3. Choose **one** of the following tasks:

- 3.1 “[T]he catalog was a window into another, freer life.” (l. 40)

Taking the quotation as a starting point, assess the significance of the catalog for the development of African Americans’ chances of pursuing the American Dream.

- 3.2 You are participating in the international UN project #FightRacism. Write an article for their website, discussing whether the Black Lives Matter initiative “We’re dreaming of a #Blackxmas. Don’t buy from White businesses this holiday season” helps to fight racism.
