


I'm going on holiday to ...?


1. Pick a slip of paper and find out your next holiday destination.
2. Write down the name of the city on a sheet of paper.
3. Find out more about your city on the Internet.

You can follow these steps:

- Type the name of your city in a search engine (e.g. Bing or Google) and click ENTER.



- Click on *Maps* or *Karten*.



- Zoom out by using the mouse wheel or by clicking on the minus symbol.



- a) In which country is your city? Write down the name of the country.
- b) Add additional geographical information, for example
 - *It is in ... (Asia, Europe, Africa ...)*
 - *It is not far away from ... (the Atlantic Ocean, the mountains ...).*
 - *It is near the ... (capital, the sea, the river Thames ...)*
 - *It is in the north / east / south / west / middle of the country.*
