3 Famous British people

Britain has many famous people who changed history, science, art and music. William Shakespeare, known as "The Bard," wrote plays like *Romeo and Juliet* and *Hamlet* (6). Queen Elizabeth I, a powerful queen in the 16th century, helped make England strong, while Queen Elizabeth II ruled even longer and (1). Sir Isaac Newton, a great scientist, discovered gravity because an apple dropped on his head. This changed how we understand the universe. Charles Darwin, a naturalist, introduced the idea of evolution, explaining how (8) develop over time. During World War II, Winston Churchill was the Prime Minister and inspired Britain (4). Alan Turing, a mathematician, helped break the German secret code during the war, saving many lives and influencing modern computers. Another famous figure is Florence Nightingale, a nurse who improved hospitals and (3). These Britons, and many more, have made Britain known for its creativity, bravery and achievements. Today, their work continues to inspire people all around the world.
