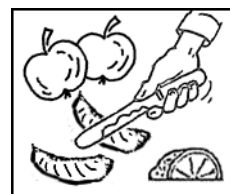

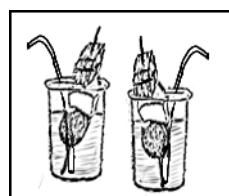

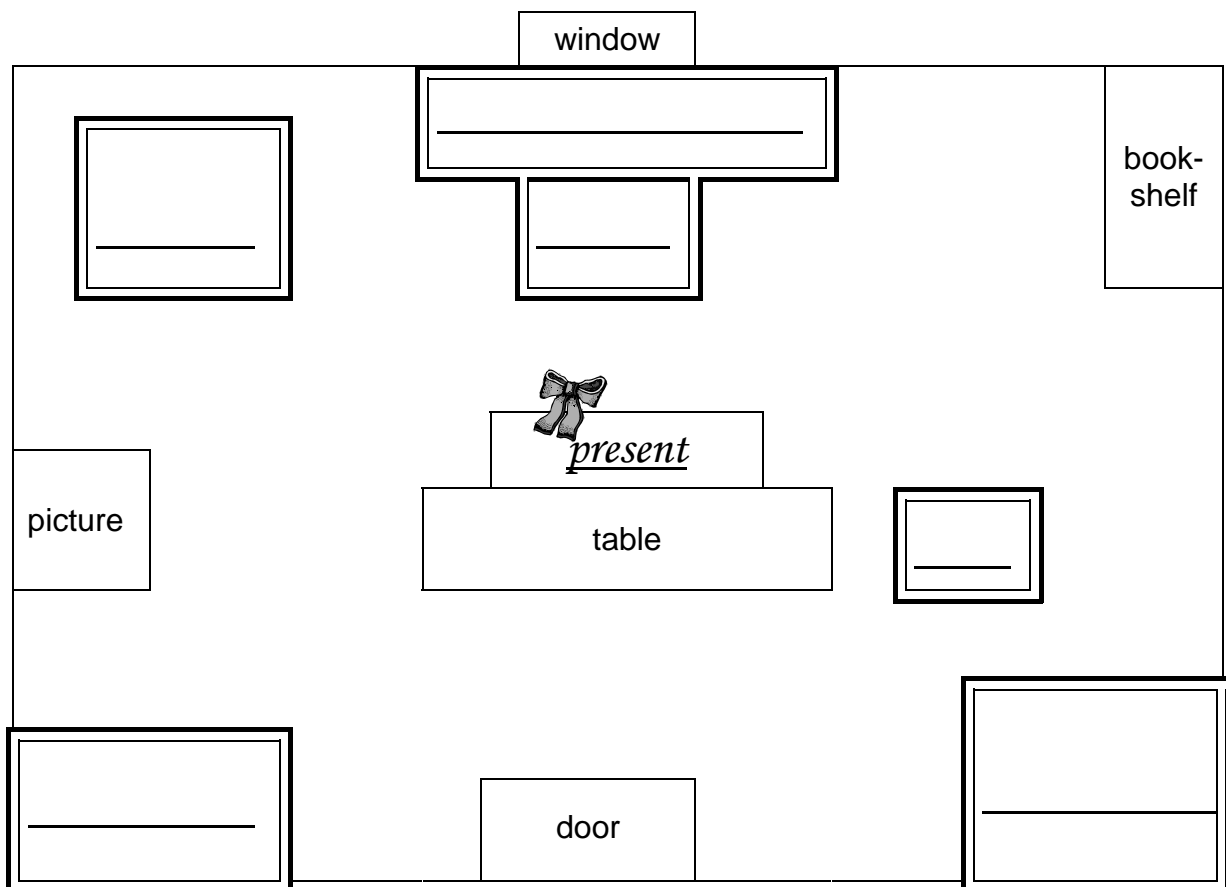
III Emma's room
